

Unfortunately there are occasionally cases where there is misuse of huts, such as physical damage to the fabric, fixtures and fittings, deliberately exceeding the maximum capacity, unacceptable behaviour or non-payment of fees. This is normally a matter for hut custodians to deal with. However, in cases where reparation for such misuse cannot be agreed between the culprit(s) and the relevant hut management committee the Council may act as arbiter if requested to do so.
